Sunday 19th June 2022



Our journey to France started on Sunday at 1:45 p.m. We met at the school, where a microbus was waiting to take us to Vienna airport. We all arrived on time. And after a lengthy goodbye, it was time to leave. The journey on the

The next day I didn't get up until 9 a.m. (We were allowed to come to school for 10), then I went to the bathroom and for breakfast, which was some crackers and butter. And then we went to school.



When we came, the headmaster officially invited all teams and spoke about Erasmus. We learned about the programme for the whole week and rules. We went to visit the school which was quite big. It has 2,500 students and there are several buildings and a big playground.

And then four university students, working as volunteers in the school, took charge of us. We played 2 games to get to know each other.

The first game was that there were 2 circles one outer and the other inner and the object of the game was that the people from the outer circle would draw the people from the inner circle, but that would be too easy, so while the people from the outer circle were drawing they still had to move one seat over every 5 seconds and start drawing someone else from the inner circle. I enjoyed this game quite a bit, except that some kids were spoiling it on purpose.



And the other game consisted of giving us some sort of task, like sorting by name alphabetically or by height, but we weren't allowed to talk. Which I quite enjoyed.

Then we went to lunch. **Their dining room looked like a cathedral. Their lunch consisted of about 5 courses, a baguette, 2 bowls of fruit or risotto, cheese (on that baguette), dessert, ice cream, a main dish, and a malt with dressing.** It was delicious. This day we had meat, veggies and mashed potatoes for our main course.

Before we came to France we had several tasks. One of them

was to prepare Kahoot questions about our country, so after lunch, we started to prepare Kahoot in international groups using what we prepared at home before. The Kahoot was in English and Spanish. At the end of the programme we presented them and the other teams were competing.

After school, which finishes at 5 p.m. we agreed to go as a Czech group to explore the city, so our hosts took us to the city centre. After the city tour we went down to walk on a high hill which overlooked the city. Then we went home.



Later I went to have a bath and lay down on the bed to relax because it is hard to switch between English, Czech and Spanish all morning. Romane suggested that we could go to the beach, which I agreed to. Romane took the dog with her. We drove to the beach for about an hour and when we got there I got out of the car and saw a nice beach.
