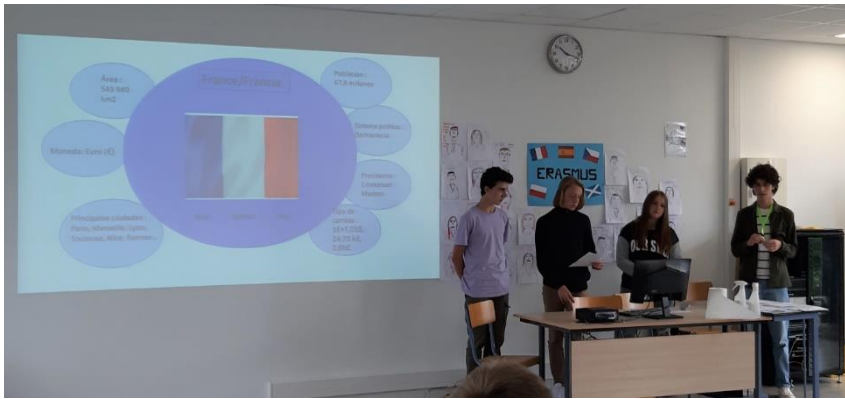


REPORT FROM 6th PROJECT MEETING IN QUIMPER, FRANCE FRIDAY 24th JUNE 2022
